

HAMMERHEAD Transport/Docking Cart

Use and Instructions

This device is intended as a transport cart for all HAMMERHEAD models. It enables the transportation of the curing machine from a truck or trailer to the job site. It also provides a means to secure the curing machine to the truck or trailer during vehicle transportation.

CAUTION: The curing machine is very heavy, it weighs approximately 300# (136kg) and requires sufficient strength and care when lifting!

The tires are pneumatic for ease of movement on rough uneven surfaces. The maximum inflation pressure is 30psi (206kPa).

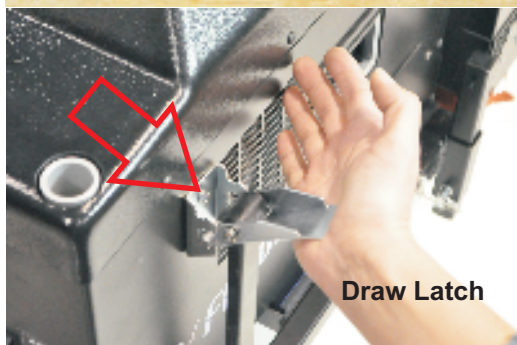
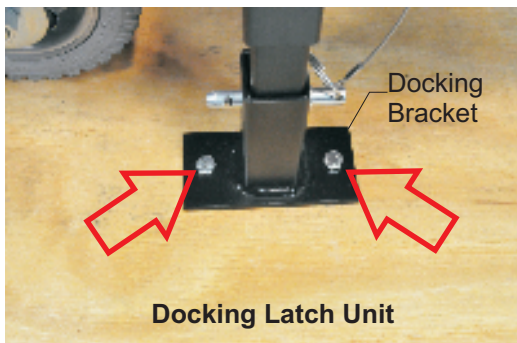
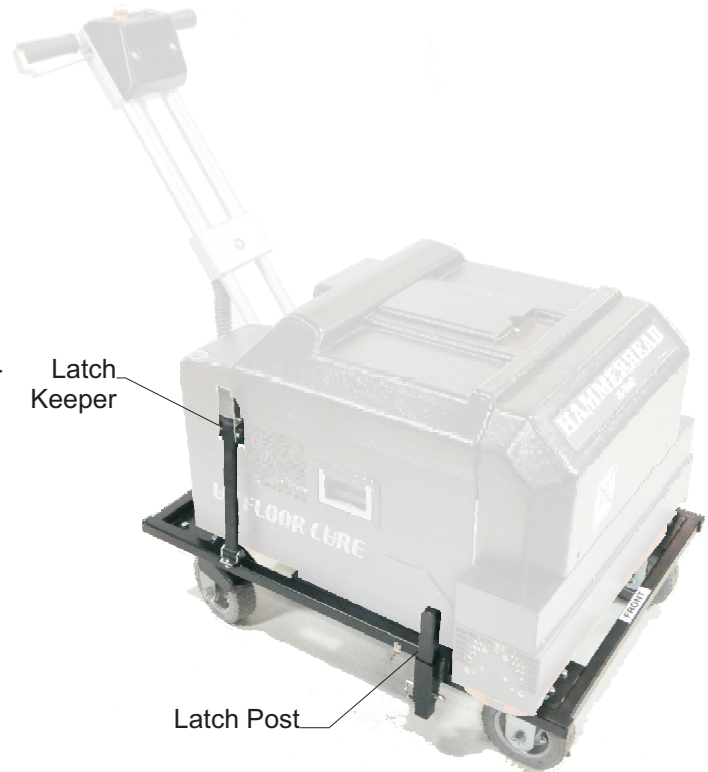
Mounting the docking brackets

The unit comes equipped with a docking latch unit to securely attach the cart and the curing machine to the transportation vehicle.

1. Position the cart in the exact place in the vehicle (truck or trailer) that you want it to be permanently mounted.
2. Mount the 2 docking brackets to the vertical latch posts using the push pins.
3. Trace the hole pattern to the floor of your truck/trailer (4 places, 2 on each bracket).
4. Move the cart out of the way. Remove the brackets by pulling out the push pins. Mount the brackets using appropriate bolts (customer supplied).

IMPORTANT NOTE:

Select extremely robust, high grade bolts that will withstand the stress imposed by the movement of the vehicle and the weight of the curing machine.



Install the Latch Keepers to the curing machine

Install the latch keepers to the curing machine using 4 10-32 screws provided.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

The 2 Draw Latches must be latched before the curing unit on the cart is moved!

The 2 vertical Latch Posts must be secured to the mating Docking Brackets using the push pins before the vehicle is moved!

The 2 vertical Latch Posts should be secured in the raised position using the push pins when the cart is being moved!

The 2 vertical Latch Posts should be lowered when the curing machine is being loaded or unloaded on the cart, this reduces the height that the curing machine must be lifted!
